

Selected recipes used at the Bacchus Wood Revel - 5<sup>th</sup> May 2007

## Saucy Venison

#### **Roast Venison**

Ingredients: Venison Roast (I used steaks), Pepper, Salt, Bacon Rub roast well with salt and pepper, place in a large roasting pan. Lay slices of fatty bacon on top of the meat and roast until done.

#### The Sauce

Ingredients: Butter, Vinegar (red wine or cider - I used Cider), Cinnamon, Roasted Venison.

In a small saucepan melt the butter, season with sugar and cinnamon. Add enough vinegar to create a slightly tart taste. Serve with venison

http://www.ydalir.co.uk/crafts/cook/recipes.htm Serves 6 people as a starter, or 3 to 4 as a vegetarian main course.

#### You need:

- 250g of open cup mushrooms,
- 175g of butter,
- 3 or 4 garlic cloves (or more if you really like garlic!),
- a good pinch of salt,
- a tablespoon or so of chopped basil.

Wipe the mushrooms and trim the stalks. Chop the garlic finely in a wooden bowl, then add the salt to it and crush it to a paste with the back of a wooden spoon.

Combine the garlic with the butter and basil. Heat a small knob of butter in your skillet and place the mushrooms on the pan gill side down. Cook for about 30 seconds.

Turn them over and spoon some of the garlic and herb butter into the cup of each mushroom. Cook until the butter has melted through the mushrooms (1 to 5 minutes depending on the size).

Serve right away with some bread to wipe up the juices.




